

## The Great Walk Together – Walk Together with Loddon Valley Ramblers on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June

This is an initiative of the Jo Cox Foundation. It is an event, held annually, that brings together people from different backgrounds around a common cause in their area.

The theme for the [Great Get Together in 2022](#) is 'welcome' and, as part of this, the Jo Cox Foundation has partnered with Refugee Week and Ramblers to run the Great Walk Together on the weekend of the 24-26 June.

As its contribution to the Week, **Loddon Valley Ramblers is organising a Walk Together on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June.**

### Details are:

- Walk starts at 2.00pm – meet outside Sutton Bowls Club
- Car parking: Chalfont Court Car Park, Chalfont Way, Lower Earley RG6 5HQ (adjacent to Suttons Bowls Club and opposite Asda) - OS Grid Ref: SU 7413 700
- Accessible by 19b and 21 Reading Transport buses (see map below):
  - No 19b Chalfont Court/Asda stop (next to car park entrance), or
  - No 21 Chalfont Circle stop and walk 300m along Chalfont Way, or
  - No 21 Chatton Close /Asda stop and walk 200m along Rushey Way to Chalfont Way
- Walk is 5.5 miles to Arborfield Church and back – easy flat paths, no stiles, leisurely pace
- A chance to see the British Museum extension, Shinfield Film Studios and the ruins of the old Arborfield Church (and some open countryside).
- Duration about 3 hours
- Walk will be led by Loddon Valley Ramblers volunteers.

All are welcome, especially those who have not walked with the Ramblers before.
